



Coach Eligibility Policy

2023-2024

Yukon takes a flexible approach to coaching requirements for Yukon coaches. Requirements are divided into two categories.

INTRA-TERRITORIAL COMPETITION

All Head Coaches must have completed:

- Criminal Record Check (CRC) with Vulnerable Sector check from the last two years*
- SafeSport Training
- Making Headway
- Making Ethical Decisions
- Foundations

Level of certification is not applicable.

All Assistant Coaches must have completed:

- Criminal Record Check (CRC) with Vulnerable Sector check from the last two years*
- SafeSport Training

Level of certification is not applicable.

EXTRA-TERRITORIAL COMPETITION

All head and assistant coaches must meet all the coaching requirements designated by the competition organizers.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All teams competing in intra- or extra-territorial competitions must have at least one designated head coach and assistant coach who meets the above requirements.
- All head and assistant coaches must have active Volleyball Yukon membership of the correct category.
- For all competitions a team participates in, its club is responsible for ensuring compliance with the competition's coaching requirements and this policy.
- Volleyball Yukon will check Coach credentials for any Team Yukon programming.

*A CRC must not be set to become more than three (3) years from current during any point of the season. For coaches who turn 18 years of age during a season, the coach will be required to provide a CRC effective on their birthday. A CRC must comply with Volleyball Yukon's CRC requirement for Persons in Authority (PIA).
