GOALS & OBJECTIVES

GOAL #1: Leadership Development

1. To increase the number of active certified coach evaluators in the Yukon.
 - a. Nominate a member(s) of the volleyball community to become a certified NCCP volleyball coach evaluator, which will cover both indoor and beach.
 - b. Send chosen individual(s) to evaluator workshop (BC, Alberta, etc.)
2. To provide coaching opportunities at all levels, and increase the number of active certified coaches in both Indoor and Beach throughout the Yukon.
 - a. Create an information document on the Volleyball Yukon Coaching pathway to certification. Especially outlining the changes from the old system to the new.
 - b. Create a tracking document of certifications for all coaches currently and upcoming, which will be updated monthly.
 - c. Encourage new coaches to create a NCCP profile and get a coaching number.
 - d. Encourage coaches to complete various on-line NCCP components which are mandatory to getting fully certified as Development Coach (old Level 1) and Advanced Development Coach (old Level 2)
 - e. Host NCCP Volleyball Canada Development Coach workshop twice a year.
 - f. Host NCCP Volleyball Canada Advanced Development Coach Workshop once a year.
3. To provide opportunities at all levels, and increase the number of active certified officials in the Yukon.
 - a. Nominate a member(s) of the volleyball community to become a certified NCCP volleyball official evaluator, which will cover both indoor and beach.
 - b. Send chosen individual(s) to evaluator nearby workshop (BC, Alberta)



4. Trained evaluator to hold a referee clinic yearly (which will include members of Team Yukon going to any of the Games).

GOAL #2 Athlete Development

1. To increase membership in community adult leagues.
 - a. Continue to host annual Co-ed Fall league and, Men's and Women's spring league in Whitehorse.
 - b. Continue to host the Canada Day Open Co-ed Reverse 4's Grass tournament and the New Year's Men's and Women's Frostbite Tournament in Whitehorse.
 - c. Create an annual Beach tournament.
2. To develop community programs and facilitate First Nations participation in volleyball throughout Yukon.
 - a. Contact various First Nations Bands and see if there is any interest in developing volleyball in Yukon.
 - b. Offer the North American Indigenous Games (NAIG) organization our support as a resource. (YASC)
3. Promote and increase participation in Beach Volleyball throughout Yukon.
 - a. Host annually at the beginning of summer a three-week fundamental and technical drop-in session, then host a summer beach league.
 - b. Host annual mid-summer beach tournament.
4. Develop a true annual Yukon Club Championships.
 - a. Create a format, which will include specific divisions for ages 13-18 years old and an open division.
 - b. Choose annual date, which falls before BC provincials and Volleyball Canada Nationals (i.e. 2nd weekend in April).
 - c. Send out information packages at YSAA High School Championships and send out to community.
 - d. Secure Courts Referees, Scorekeepers, Volunteers, Sponsorships and Prizes.
5. Continue to provide opportunities for elite athletes to develop skills and experiences in volleyball.
 - a. To maintain a fair and equitable system of fund allocation to teams travelling to competitions outside of the Territory (Create Volleyball Yukon Funding Application).
 - b. Create a summer weekend camp for all athletes 13-18 years old.
 - c. Create an affiliation with Volleyball Canada (VC) to provide the Volleyball Canada Commitment to Excellence yearly program



GOAL #3 Administration and Organizational Development

1. To increase Organizational Structure.
2. Improve communications between affiliates and Executive Members.
3. To improve resources available to Volleyball Yukon coaches, athletes and affiliates.
4. To Improve and maintain records and filing system of all Volleyball Yukon events and finances. (Finances, shared drive, website)

GOAL #4 Special Project and Community Development

1. To encourage communities to affiliate with Volleyball Yukon.
2. To create GOALLINE online registration for all athletes, coaches, officials and any events.
3. Continue to increase volleyball exposure throughout the communities.

GOAL #5 Facility Maintenance and Operation

1. Look into building a pure volleyball facility in Whitehorse.
2. Encourage YTG to build and upgrade suitable facilities in Yukon. (beach courts)
